## Tournament Rules

- Each game will be 90 minutes with a 10 minute half time break.
- After Game 2 and Game 4 on the finals week, there will be a short presentation.
- FIFA rules apply to the structure of the ladder, so if the points are tied it will be determined by goal difference and if the goal difference is tied, it will then be determined by majority goals scored.
- The above rules are a summary only and in the event of any dispute the decision of the competition organisers shall be final and no correspondence will be entered into.
- In the event of a draw at full time in the final, extra time will be played and then a penalty shoot out will be conducted to find the winning team.
- The tournament will be **UNLIMITED INTERCHANGE** however, a player can only enter the field of play once the referee gives him the go ahead.
- Team sheets will be required for every game.
- Players receiving two yellow cards in the tournament will be ineligible to play in the next game of the tournament. Players receiving a red card will also be disqualified from taking any further part in the competition and subjected to their Associations normal disciplinary procedures.
- On the first week of the tournament (**6 February 2010**), each club will be required to pay for their share of the referee's costs for the entirety of the tournament amounting to **\$342**.
- Official referees will be provided for all games however participating clubs will be required to provide linesmen.
